Preparing for our Centenary

The 100th anniversary of our church is an important milestone that needs to be commemorated appropriately. The air conditioning is a worthwhile addition. Generous people have already furnished vestments and altar furnishings, candelabra, a paschal candle stand, and even a beautiful new outdoor sign highlighting this special occasion. Since the bishop will be consecrating the church at our anniversary celebration, a new altar has been installed with a proper stone mensa required by the law of the church. Parishioners have already pledged to fund the wall sconces, which will be needed to mark the places where the bishop will anoint the walls. Many people have complimented the look of the new walls and paintings in the sanctuary. To complement all this, painting of the window frames to highlight and match the stained-glass windows will begin in the next couple of weeks. It is also my hope that the wood panelling in the sanctuary can be removed and the walls painted to match the window frames, highlighting the beautiful crucifix above the tabernacle.
